The restaurant boat, 'My Fair Lady', is booked for our exclusive use and will serve a full 3 course meal while cruising between Camden Lock and Little Venice on the Regents Canal returning to Camden about three hours later. There is a toilet on board.

In an effort to organise the event outside of the normal 'Masonic season' and avoid the peak holiday times when members may be away, I have booked the following date. Our Provincial Grand Supreme Ruler, Trevor Dutt, hopes to see you on board so please put the date in your diary and make every effort to support this event.

**SUNDAY 2nd July 2017 meet on the quay-side at 12:30
Cruise departs at 1 PM and returns at about 3:30 PM**

My Fair Lady can accommodate 60 sitting down for a full meal. There will be waitress service and a cash bar on board. As all food is prepared on board it will be very helpful if you would pre-order your choice of menu so that sufficient of each choice will be available on the day. The cruise starts from and returns to Camden Lock, 250 Camden High Street, NW1 8QS. Camden is a great area to visit and is of course home to the famous Camden Market and lots of shops and stalls all along the High Street. This means that Camden gets VERY busy at the weekend and parking is VERY difficult. I suggest therefore that you travel by underground to Camden Town station on the Northern Line. Turn right out of the station and walk along Camden High Street until you reach the bridge over the canal. Looking over the right-hand side of the bridge you will see Walkers Quay below and the My Fair Lady boat moored at the quay. Entrance to the quay is through the shop at the side of the bridge – 250 Camden High Street. As soon as you enter the shop go down the stairs on the right onto the quay. Meet on the quay-side at 12:30. We cruise at 1PM.
